Short and Long E

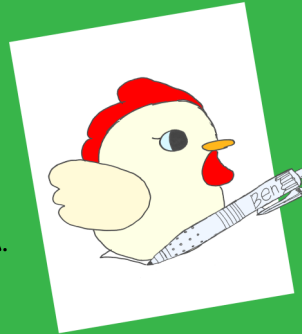
Japanese and English are very different, but sometimes they sound the same.

(エ, ě).



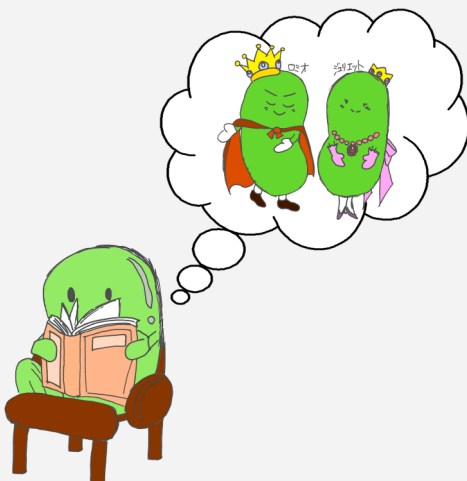
There is a team of beans.

They are green.

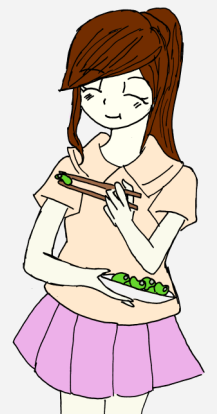
and they can read
